Student Art Challenge #1: Class Project

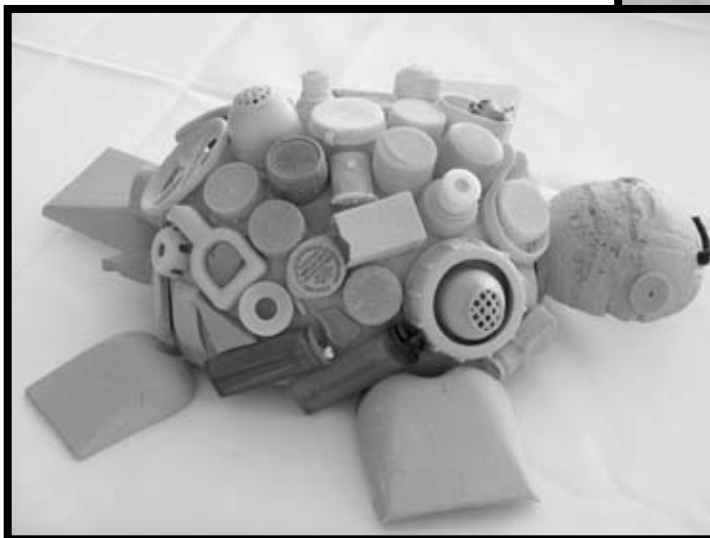
Storybook Theatre is offering this challenge to one class on Kaua‘i. To participate in the challenge, write a letter to the Director of Storybook Theatre describing why your class should be chosen for the challenge. If your class is chosen, you will be required to organize at least one beach cleanup (see Beach Cleanup Activity Sheet) and one recycling drive. Storybook Theatre will lend you the wooden base of a coral reef. Your class will then take the items that you have collected, attach them to the wooden reef, and turn them into a beautiful piece of artwork. Your artwork will then be displayed at Storybook Theatre for the Hanapepe Orchid and Art Festival in 2014, to teach others about the importance of recycling. Don't forget to document your progress; you could make it into the news!
